## NOTIFICATION TO CONSULAR OFFICERS OF ARREST OR DETENTION (NCOAD) INSTRUCTIONS NON-MANDATORY REPORTING COUNTRY

- 1. Confirm that the subject is a national from a non-mandatory reporting country and is requesting that notification to the relevant consular officer is made.
- 2. Complete as much of the non-mandatory reporting version of the NCOAD as possible.
- 3. Send a photocopy of the NCOAD via facsimile to the appropriate consulate office. Members should refer to the Consulate List Web Site for information pertaining to consulate offices from the consulate list link located on the Departments' Intranet home page.
- 4. Any required consulate notification will be considered completed if the sending Department fax machine provides the member sending the fax with:
  - a. a confirmation printout.
  - b. a digital display indicating "Send Complete."
- 5. If notification is required and a facsimile message cannot be sent, the station supervisor, or an authorized designee, will make the notification by telephone. If notification attempts by facsimile and telephone are unsuccessful, the station supervisor or investigating member will confer with the Special Events Unit (Pax 0303, or Bell 5-5253) and attempt to find an accurate contact number. If notification cannot be made, the NCOAD will be sent via facsimile with a To- From-Subject Report to the Special Events Unit, indicating that a consular notification could not be made.
- 6. Arrest Report
  - a. If an Arrest Report has been completed, send the completed NCOAD to the Records Division.
  - b. If an Arrest Report has not been completed, forward the NCOAD and any relevant reports to the Special Events Unit.
- 7. For additional Information, members should refer to the Special Orders entitled "Procedures for the Arrest and Detention of Foreign Nationals" and "Foreign Mission Personnel and Foreign Nationals."
