- ☐ Assign at least one Area Team to the location of the ERP.
- ☐ Conduct an assessment of resources assigned and deploy additional resources to serve as a support function.
- ☐ Prepare a daily report of all enforcement activity taken during the ERP and submit to the Chief, Bureau of Patrol.

SPECIAL FUNCTIONS DIVISION

- ☐ Assign at least one SORT Vehicle to the location of the ERP.
- ☐ Consider deployment of the Helicopter and/or Canine unit to conduct the appropriate missions.
- ☐ Assign the Traffic Section to conduct enforcement missions and DUI checkpoints.
- ☐ Assign the Troubled Buildings Unit to conduct missions in the location of the ERP.

COMMANDER, DISTRICT _____

- ☐ Ensure a multifaceted response within their district, incorporating beat integrity, information gathered from the District Intelligence Officer, and related gang conflict and potential gang retaliations intelligence from the CPIC.
- ☐ Establish and staff an ERP Command Post.
- ☐ Request assistance of appropriate State and/or Federal partners.
- ☐ Ensure targeted vehicle enforcement missions are conducted focusing on impounding vehicles.
- ☐ Incorporate the GVRS where appropriate, including vehicle impoundment & I-Bond policy for verified gang members.
- ☐ Consult with the Commander, Narcotics Division, relative to Narcotics Division Teams as support within the district.
- ☐ Organize the Cook County Gang Intervention Probation Program (GIPP) check where appropriate.
- ☐ Implement the Targeted Repeat Offender Apprehension and Prosecution (TRAP) program.
- ☐ Ensure district members and supervisors are briefed relative to intelligence and enforcement missions/areas.
- ☐ Coordinate with the Chief, Bureau of Patrol and ensure the following programs are used:
 - ☐ Custom Notifications
 - ☐ Violence Reduction Strategy gang call in

CHIEF, BUREAU OF DETECTIVES

- ☐ Immediately consult with the Chief, Bureau of Patrol, upon implementation of the ERP.
- ☐ Immediately deploy all available resources of the Fugitive Apprehension Unit to the ERP.
- ☐ Ensure positive debriefings are sought from arrestees in reference to the shootings in the ERP districts.
- ☐ Ensure Area Violent Crimes Detective are embedded in the district of concern and debriefings are conducted with arrestees on any of the shootings in the focus deployment areas.
- ☐ Ensure supervisors forward all activity, through chain of command, to the Chief, Bureau of Detectives.
- ☐ Ensure Area supervisors provide a brief synopsis of each shooting to include an opinion as to whether the shooting is related to the current conflict/trend or is a separate unrelated shooting (domestic, robbery, accidental, etc.).
- ☐ Ensure the synopsis is to be sent via email, through chain of command, to the Area Commander, Executive Officer, and Chief, Bureau of Detectives.

	- seek out witnesses and interview victims

	<input type="checkbox"/> Conduct joint missions with outside agencies, when an ERP is initiated.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Cover high-risk, gang-related funerals that involve active gang investigations, high-ranking gang leaders, or present a high probability of retaliation.
<input type="checkbox"/> Ensure Gang School Safety Teams (GSST) conduct interventions with the involved students in the presence of a parent or school representative when an incident of school-related gang violence occurs.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Ensure that parolee compliance checks are completed where appropriate after the implementation of the ERP.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Monitor social media sources with the goal of garnering real-time gang intelligence and preventing retaliatory gang-related violence.

	<input type="checkbox"/> Disseminate Gang Faction Profiles on gangs involved in the violence.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Coordinate information with the Gang Enforcement Teams.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Ensure that notifications from the field are disseminated in a timely manner.
	<input type="checkbox"/> Provide intelligence through the Daily Intelligence Bulletin (DIBS).
	<input type="checkbox"/> Issue PDT messages, Information bulletins and other Officer Safety Bulletins where appropriate.
	<input type="checkbox"/> When Chicago Public Schools (CPS) students are involved, ensure that the daily briefing call with CPS addresses the violence and ensures the proper deployment of personnel.
