The motor vehicle described is presently at the Chicago Police Department Automotive Pound located at 10301 South Doty Avenue, Chicago, IL 60617, and is subject to an administrative penalty, towing and accruing storage charges. If the administrative penalty and other fees are not paid in full or if they are paid in full and you fail to redeem your vehicle within 18 days of this notice, your vehicle will be deemed unclaimed and the vehicle and its contents, including the license plate and the city sticker, may be disposed of according to the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/4-201, et. seq.) and Chapter 9-92 of the Municipal Code of Chicago ("Code"). That means that your vehicle may be sold as scrap in accordance with section 9-92-100(b) of the Code, sold at auction in accordance with section 9-92-100(c) of the Code, or reserved for use by the various city departments in accordance with section 9-92-100(d) of the Code. For more information on vehicle disposal, please call 312-745-6270. Pursuant to section 9-92-100(a) of the Code, the registered owner has the right to request one extension of 15 days before a vehicle is sold or otherwise disposed of.

Towing: \$150 (\$250 for vehicles 8,000 lbs. or more)

Storage: \$25 per day (\$50 per day for vehicles 8,000 lbs. or more) up to a maximum of \$1,000. Exceptions may apply to the storage fee amount.

The owner (title holder or lessee) may secure the release of the vehicle by paying the appropriate administrative penalty plus tow and storage fees, as provided above, and all amounts due for all outstanding final determinations for parking, standing, compliance, automated traffic law enforcement system or automated speed enforcement system violations incurred, including all related costs. The payment can be made by cash or credit card in person at the **Central Hearing Facility, 400 W. Superior St., Chicago, IL** during business hours as listed below:

Monday through Friday: 8:30 am - 4:30 pm (closed Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays).

The owner (title holder or lessee) can claim the vehicle at the pound location listed above after making payment by presenting proof of ownership and a release order receipt. A lien holder (or lessor) may obtain possession of the impounded vehicle upon payment of applicable towing and storage fees and submission of required documents. Lien holders and lessors may obtain additional information by calling (312) 742 - 6121.
