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ITEM:

TROUSERS, WOOL, FEMALE - ALTERNATE

MATERIAL:

#460-96, Raeford Worsted, 14 oz. #386-14, Metcalf Bros., 14 oz.

CONSTRUCTION:

Plain pair of straight legged pants with allowance for a modified flare.

Seams: To be plain

Zipper: Zipper on left side on the seam

Waistband: To be 2" wide when finished and the waistband lining is to be made with Snugtex , to prevent shirt coming out of pants, closure adjusting size of waistband utilizing Velcro fastener. To be made with seven belt loops, 1" wide, 2" deep, sewn in the waistband seam.

Pockets: To have two side pockets, western style, and two back pockets with outside openings to measure approximately 7" on the inside from bottom of band to bottom of pocket, approximately 9" deep.

<u>Special Instructions to Cutter</u>: The finished length of the pants is to be cut so that the front edge of the pants touches the shoe in a straight line. The finished width of the pants must not be less than 17" wide nor more than 20" wide.

Crotch Lining: The crotch to be lined with linen or cotton material and to be stay-taped.

Outlets: There is to be a 2" outlet at the waist, and a 2" turnup at the bottom.

Maker's Specification Guarantee/Identification Tag: This tag is furnished by the Chicago Police Department and will be sewn on the inside front of the waistband on the right side, or on the underside of the right hip pocket, or inside the back right or left pocket by the manufacturer or uniform supply.

In all areas not specifically covered by this specification, the garment will conform to the standard sample which may be seen at the Research and Development Division, Chicago Police Department.
