ITEMS:

COVERALLS - ONE PIECE (SPECIALIZED AND UTILITY)

ITEM 1:

COVERALLS - SPECIALIZED

STYLES:

One piece "jumpsuit" concept, zipper or snap front, winter and summer types.

MATERIAL:

Type A - Summer: 65% polyester - 35% cotton or 50% polyester -50% cotton, permanent press finish, dark blue in color.

Type B - Winter: Same as Type A, but is to be lined with 100% nylon quilted over a 100% polyester fiber insulator or approved equal.

CONSTRUCTION:

Pocketing: Pockets will be constructed of heavy duty #2.50 boat sail drill or approved equal.

Pockets: Two upper patch pockets, two lower front insert pockets and two rear patch pockets. Tool pocket on legs and side pocket vents are authorized.

Stitching: All stitching will be triple stitched, with welted seams. All loose edges are to be serged.

Zipper/snaps: Zippers will be heavy duty aluminum or brass and be rust proof. Zippers shall be of American manufacture and shall be either Talon or Scovill.

Snaps will be nickel or brass and must resist weathering.

Snap front and zipper front closures must be concealed by means of a fly front or material covering.

Zipper top snaps, wrist snaps and ankle snaps are authorized. These snaps may be exposed.

Waistband: Waistbands must be sewn on and reinforced. Selfadjusting elastic waistbands are permissible.

Patches: The octagonal cotton Chicago Police shoulder patch will be sewn centered on the left sleeve 3/4" from the shoulder seam. The City of Chicago Flag shoulder patch will be sewn centered on the right sleeve 1-1/4" below the shoulder seam. Chevrons will be sewn centered on both sleeves with the upper point of the chevron facing up and measuring 5-1/2" from the shoulder seam. A patch measuring approximately 12" \times 4-1/2" will be sewn on the rear of the garment approximately 6" down from the collar seam. This patch will spell the word "Police" in bold print measuring 3" tall. The width of the embroidered letters will be 1/2". This patch will be 65% polyester - 35% cotton, dark blue in color. Embroidery will be continuous filament, prime quality thread, vat dyed to withstand laundering and dry PAGE cleaning.

CONSTRUCTION: (continued)

Patches (continued): The patch back must be laminated to ensure stiffness. Laminated patches must have at least 1 layer of crinoline (OlC), or equal. There shall be no puckering or bunching of the exposed side of the patch.

A 3/16" rolled merrowed border will be stitched on the outer edge of the rectangular patch. A 1/4" overlap will complete the merrowed border and the loose ends of the stitching will be secured to the back side of the patch. Embroidered letters and merrowed border will match Robison-Antron Textile Co. blue FD-13. If the color does not match the above, the color must be approved by the Chicago Police Department, Research and Development Division.

Maker's Specification Guarantee Tag: No manufacturer or representative may suggest that a garment is prescribed without prior inspection of completed sample garments and written authorization of the Director, Research and Development Division, Chicago Police Department.

AUTHORIZATIONS/ RESTRICTIONS:

- 1. This optional garment may be utilized by authorized personnel only as approved by a respective bureau deputy superintendent.
- 2. Chicago Police and City of Chicago Flag shoulder patches may be removed upon approval of the member's bureau deputy superintendent.
- 3. This garment will normally be worn over a prescribed field or utility uniform. However, circumstances may require that this garment be worn over citizen's dress attire.
- 4. The utility uniform cap is to be worn with this garment unless otherwise authorized by a respective bureau deputy superintendent.
